

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Thank you for considering Hilltop Hotel to organise and host your upcoming wedding!

Please see below the minimum documentation that the Registry Office of Pallini requires for your marriage:

- Certificates of No Impediment
- Full Birth Certificates.
- Evidence of dissolution of previous marriages, (e.g. Decree Absolute Divorce Papers or Death Certificates).
- Evidence of any change in name or surname.
- Photocopies of passports
- Applications for Marriage

All documents emanating from foreign countries (including Britain) which are to be used in Greece must be officially legalized with the Hague Convention "Apostille" (except the Certificate of No Impediment only from Germany, Austria, Spain, Italy, France, Portugal, Luxembourg, Holland, Turkey & Poland) and need to be officially translated (no exceptions) by a Greek Consulate abroad or, if in Greece, by the Translations Bureau of the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs or by Greek Lawyer (official Translator) officially legalized by Lawyer's Association.
