FORMALITIES for the CIVIL WEDDING

To legally marry in Cyprus you must provide the following:

- Passports
- Affidavit letters for each person (Proof of single status)
- Copies of two witnesses' passports, showing name & passport numbers. Witnesses must be over 18.

IF APPLICABLE

- Divorce certificate / Decree absolute – this must be an original copy with an apostille stamp on it
- Death certificate – if widowed
- For any person under 21 years of age, written signed permission from their parents is required.
- Baptism certificates (for Church weddings only).

IMPORTANT NOTES

- ✚ *The above papers must be sent to the hotel wedding planner a month before the wedding date so as to check them with the Town Hall before the couple's arrival.
- ✚ You will need to be in Cyprus at least two working days prior to your wedding in order to submit the necessary paperwork to the Town Hall / church for your wedding.
- ✚ Civil weddings can be arranged during week days between 3:30pm – 6:00pm.
- ✚ The Town Hall is open between 8:30 – 10am Monday to Fridays, in order to submit the necessary paperwork.
- ✚ No appointments are taken
- ✚ The civil ceremony lasts ten minutes and the couple is given one certificate.
- ✚ If the couple request an extra civil certificate, then an additional fee of €15 is required.
- ✚ A minimum stay of two nights is required in order to hold your wedding at Almyra
- ✚ To hold your wedding ceremony at the Almyra, you must also hold your wedding reception / dinner here.
- ✚ We only hold one wedding / wedding reception per day on the hotel premises.

TOWN HALL FEE €631.92

This is the total fee payable directly to the Town Hall for your marriage licence and registrar's fees.
