

Documents and fees for Weddings in Paphos

To all **British Citizens** getting married in Paphos the following documents must be submitted:

DOCUMENTS

- 1) Original passports.
- 2) If you are single, then a certificate from a solicitor of the UK is required, stating that you are free to get married. This certificate must be issued on headed paper of the solicitor's firm, or, if this is issued on blank paper, must be signed and stamped by the solicitor – please make sure that the solicitor's stamp shows clearly the name, address and the word 'solicitor.'
- 3) If you are divorced, you are required to bring with you the original Divorce Certificate – which must be final and absolute. **Also**, you must have the certificate described in 2) (see above).
- 4) If you are a widow/widower, you are required to bring with you the original Death certificate of your husband/wife. **Also**, you must have the certificate described in 2) (see above).
- 5) If one of you is **under 18 years old**, you must also bring a written letter of consent from your father which is certified by a solicitor from your country.
- 6) Passport photocopies of two witnesses for the wedding ceremony who must be over 18 years of age.

FEES

- a) Special Marriage Fee €281.92 – wedding venue - Paphos Town Hall (special marriage means marriage within one to two days after the submission of your application.)
- b) Special Marriage Fee €631.92 – wedding venue – in a hotel resort in Paphos (special marriage means marriage within one to two days after the submission of your application.)
- c) Usual Marriage Fee €128.15 – wedding venue - Paphos Town Hall (the marriage is performed at least 15 days after the submission of your application.)
- d) Usual Marriage Fee €478.15 – wedding venue – in a hotel resort in Paphos (the marriage is performed at least 15 days after the submission of your application.)

Nothing can be done in advance. The application is submitted and accepted only in the presence of the people that are getting married. The working days are Monday to Friday and applications are accepted between 8.30 – 10.00 hrs.

It is recommended to send all the necessary certificates by fax (0035-26-822364) so that you can be sure that everything is correct. The originals will still need to be submitted upon your arrival in Paphos.
